Ashley River Baptist Church Student Ministry Code of Conduct

At all times, the Student Ministry will lovingly attempt to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and the growth of the Christ-life is encouraged with every student. **The Student Ministry is committed to provide an environment for all students that is safe and conducive to Spiritual Growth.** Often, discipline is required at church sponsored events or activities. The Student Ministry is a team ministry with parents, leadership, and youth. Parents will be responsible for the discipline of their youth, and the Student Ministry will set clear parameters of what is expected. If the rules or parameters that are set for a particular activity or those listed below are broken, the action described below will be taken.

Discipline policy:

1. After sufficient warning, the teenager will be dismissed from the meeting/activity and will not be permitted back until a meeting is set up with the Youth Pastor, parents or guardian, and the teenager. At that meeting, some sort of agreement on future behavior will be reached.
2. On a retreat, the student will have 24 hours after returning home to inform his parents of the misbehavior, after which a meeting will be needed before a future trip can be taken by the student with the church. If contact is not made by the parent, a contact will be made from the Student Ministry Office.
3. If the student is continually malicious on an out-of-town retreat, or behavior is of a seriously unacceptable nature, the parents will be notified and, if necessary, arrangements will be made to return the student home before the retreat is over. If behavior at any regular event is continually malicious, the student will not be permitted on the Church property until another standard is put in place.

NO GIRLS IN GUYS' ROOMS OR GUYS IN GIRLS' ROOMS. It is not a matter of trust, it is a matter of courtesy and integrity.

NO WANDERING OFF BY YOURSELF. Do not be a loner. This is a group effort. We are all in this together. Get to know someone new. Being by yourself will not be accepted. Participation in planned activities is expected.

DO NOT BRING VALUABLES. If it will ruin your trip if you lose something (or even if it appears that something was stolen) do not bring that item. Accusations and investigations will not be a part of any trip. If you need help handling your money, give it to a sponsor to keep it for you.

BE A GOOD EXAMPLE OF WHAT A CHRISTIAN SHOULD BE. Avoid selfishness, jealousy, backstabbing and other negative characteristics. Focus on what is positive.

NO INAPPROPRIATE PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION (PDA) ON STUDENT MINISTRY ACTIVITIES. No physical affection will be permitted while at any Student Ministry activity. You must always be in group settings. Spend time with everyone, not just one person. While riding on bus/van, no sleeping in the same seat with the opposite sex, no shared blankets, no sitting or leaning on one another, and when dark, a reading light must be on if you choose to sit together.

ABSOLUTELY NO TOBACCO, DRUGS, OR ALCOHOL. This is an automatic ticket home at your parents' expense.

DRESS APPROPRIATELY. Clothing that is inappropriate should not be brought on a trip or worn in any Student Ministry setting.
