One of the top questions students ask today: What is my purpose in life? What is my place in this world? Students are constantly looking for answers and for direction in how to live. Christian students, especially, are looking for some ideas on how to live out their Christian lives effectively. Paul wrote the Book of Colossians to a group of new believers who needed to understand what it meant to follow Christ as Lord. This unit will help students know Jesus better as Lord and Savior. They will understand what it means to make His life their life.
