(workout and locker facilities for 16 and over only) Multiple restaurants and pizza is always a delivery away for that extra meal. We will have evening meetings together in the spacious den with ample places to have a personal worship experience as well. Parents are welcome to come and consider private resort lodging if available.

The Details

- ◇ Leave Friday early as possible. Eat dinner on the road. Arrive, move in.
- ◇ Saturday & Sunday 13 hours of Skiing available from 9am-10pm. Take the shuttle or ride together on the bus each day.
- ◇ You can ski the max all day, take breaks back at the lodge via shuttle or ski one day only
- ◇ Saturday and Sunday night @ 10:30pm we will have time of worship and inspiration together. Daily personal worship opportunities will be provided as well.
- ◇ After that until 2am the Recreation facilities remain open (adult supervised), turn in by midnight.
- ◇ Breakfast will be continental style in the lodge
- ◇ Lunch (two meals) provided at the slope, dinner (2) will be on your own. (bring money for fast food, dine nice, or bring PB&J)
- ◇ On the way back Monday lunch and dinner fast food will be an option.
- ◇ Travel by bus back home, leaving Monday mid morning, return before dinner Monday around 6pm.
- ◇ 4 Meals you cover total: 3 dinners, one lunch (2 are while traveling)

Add on/take away
